Vice President Frank Fopiano called the meeting to order at 7:05.

Erin Billbray led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Frank Fopiano introduced the guest speaker, Erin Billbray who is running for Congress, District 3. Erin Billbray and her family have deep roots in Nevada where Erin has a long history of community service. She gave a warm and impassioned speech about how she and her husband she started a children's health clinic that provides free health care for Southern Nevada kids, the first and only organization of its kind. She also founded "Emerge" that has trained over 100 Nevada women for political leadership roles. Not to mention the American Diabetes Foundation and the Agassi Foundation where she has played an important role. As opposed to her opponent, Joe Heck, who wants to privatize Social Security and Medicare, Erin wants to strengthen these popular programs. She is also pro-choice as opposed to Joe Heck who wants no abortion at all, not even in rape and incest cases. In Congress she would strengthen the middle class and support families by expanding Head Start, paid family leave, and access to affordable child care.

No candidates presented themselves (they were all at the Paradise Democratic Club dinner) but the Clark County Democratic Party announced its first annual CCDP Kick Ass Country, Blues and Brews Micro-Brew Tasting Event from 6 PM to midnight on October 17 in the Artifice.
