Dan Kruger introduced the guest speakers Ruben Murillo and Nick Di Archangel from The Education Initiative (TEI). This Initiative will appear on the ballot in November. If passed, it will provide funding for Nevada's K-12 public schools. TEI will impose a 2 % margins tax on businesses earning more than a million a year in revenue. TEI is estimated to raise from \$ 400 to \$ 700 million per year for K-12 public education. The money would go to reduce class size and give educators what they need to help prepare students for the jobs of the future.

After a question and answer session, Chris Miller was acknowledged as the chairman of the Clark County Democratic Party.
